

## **DESIGN SPECIFICATIONS**

- Design must be submitted on an official entry form available at Rogers Free Library, 136 Express Printing and the Bristol Town Hall.
- RED, WHITE and BLUE are the ONLY colors to be used in the button. Black outline is acceptable.
- 3. Design MUST have patriotic theme.
- 4. Design MUST include the following: Bristol; 239th; July 4,2024
- Media accepted; crayons, watercolor, markers, colored pencils, etc. NO computer generated art.
- 6. Winning design may be enhanced for clarity when manufactured.
- 7. Design will become the property of the Bristol Fourth of July Committee.
- Entries not complying with the design specifications will not be eligible for a prize.
